The pertinent sections and tables of the referenced documents will be reviewed and explained. We will also install tabs in these books so that your search during the exam is easier. The BLD seminar starts at 1:00 and will end no later than 4:00 PM.

Basic Contractor Business Licensing Class



Companies who are not previously licensed in Virginia must complete this course prior to obtaining a contractor license for Class A, B, or C.

This eight hour course is recognized by the Virginia Board for Contractors as fully meeting the requirements of 18 VAC 50-22-40.F, 22.50.H and 22.60.H that requires "A member of Responsible Management shall have successfully completed a board approved basic business course." The course also meets the requirements of 18VAC50-22.200 for contractors who have signed a consent order and are required to attend remedial education.

Course Content

This course is recognized by the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation (DPOR) as meeting the requirements for pre-licensure or remedial education. Course material includes a manual with a sample contract, legal forms, and all the posters required by state and federal agencies. This course is intended for first time applicants for a Class C, B or A license or changing a business type. Manual

The manual contains state and federal regulations and information about business structure, employment law, liens and other essential things to know in order to practice as a contractor.

Cost \$179 for the class and the manual. Class is held in Richmond.

Determining Licensing Classification:

The three classes of contractor licenses are: **Class A**, **Class B**, and **Class C**. Each class of license is based upon the value of the project or contract and gross yearly revenue. A company does not need to be a Class C contractor before moving to a Class B or Class A contractor.

Class A contractors perform or manage construction, removal, repair, or improvements when the total value of a single contract or project is \$120,000 or more, or the total value of all such construction, removal, repair, or improvement contracts undertaken by such person within any twelve-month period is \$750,000 or more.

Class B contractors perform or manage construction, removal, repair, or improvements when the total value of a single contract or project is \$10,000 or more, but less than \$120,000, or the total value of all such construction, removal, repair, or improvement contracts undertaken by such person within any twelve-month period is \$150,000 or more, but less than \$750,000.

Class C contractors perform or manage construction, removal, repair, or improvements when the total value of a single contract or project is over \$1,000 but less than \$10,000, or the total value of all such construction, removal, repair, or improvements undertaken by such person within any twelve-month period is no more than \$150,000.

Building (BLD) Contractors - A contractor with a building (BLD) classification may perform what's typically called general contracting; that is, commercial, residential (single family, two-family or multifamily) and remodeling. A BLD classification is typically required if the contractor will be changing the outside footprint of a structure, building decks with roofs, or building from the ground up.
